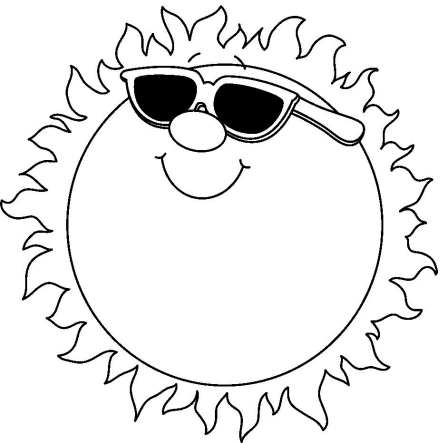


Emerald Class: Step into Summer!
