Important Date Change

Over the summer we are having some building work completed which is being funded and led by the Local Authority. All of the lights in school are being replaced with LEDs and we are having some significant roof work done at both the front and back of school. During the whole of the summer period, staff are not allowed on-site. As I am sure you know, the school holidays are a time when teachers set up their classrooms and get everything prepared for the new term, cleaners are in and areas such as the kitchen and all food preparation areas are deep cleaned. The work starts on Thursday 25th July and ends on Friday 30th August - these timescales will not give us enough time to be fully ready for the new term. The Governors and I have therefore made the decision that school will re-open on Thursday 5th September for children - school will finish at 3.15pm on this day. These additional 2 days will give teachers, TAs, cleaners and maintenance staff time to ensure school is fully prepared, clean and safe for the children's return.

As you know, we keep school open until 4.15pm each Thursday meaning that every child benefits from an additional 45mins of learning per week therefore we are able to use some of this time as a guarantee that children will still have their equivalent of 190 days in school over the academic year. I hope this doesn't cause you too much inconvenience but as always, when decisions like this are taken, it is in the best interests of the children.


