World Religion Day!



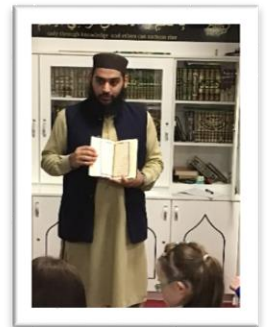
Year 2, take a step back in time

Purple and Blue class visited Tatton Park this week and travelled back in time to 1887, when the Prince and Princess of Wales honoured Tatton with a visit. To help with the preparations, the children were recruited as extra servants. Before getting down to work, the new servants were given strict instructions by the housekeeper regarding their behaviour and social status of the time. The servants were involved in the day to day running of the mansion through a range of hands on activities. New servants were also taken around the mansion so they could see how much work there was to be done and what life was like living in a grand house. It was an amazing experience and a great way for the children to learn by immersing themselves in this era.



Today in school, we have had our very own World Religion Day celebration. This day is typically celebrated every January on the third Sunday of the month. Its aim is to promote understanding and peace between all religions, encouraging people to learn about other faiths.
