Next Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June is an Inset day and School and Nursery will be closed.


## Weather For Walking!

Finally, the weather is looking settled enough to undertake our massive 10k walk in aid of St Rocco's Hospice. We have already had some amazing donations into school in-excess of £400 taking the total to almost £1000!

Some classes will be doing a bit each day and some will do it all at once – we are hoping for Wednesday but just in case the weather changes, I will allow children to come into school all week in sportswear (team tops/strips will be allowed for this special week).

Remember, every child who brings in a donation of over £3 will receive the special 'I walked 10k' metal pin badge for their badge-hat; there have only been 100 made so get your sponsor money asap!

This week is Drowning Prevention Week. Sadly, there are so many of our children who cannot swim or know how to keep themselves safe in water. As with all primary schools, we send our children swimming as part of the national curriculum but even with these weekly, small-group sessions, our most recent data from the pool has told us that less than 25% of children have reached the standard expected nationally. We believe that he main reason for this is that many of the children go into the group



This week we have had an assembly all about being safe in water and what to do in an emergency, children are also invited to take part in a poster design competition launched by Livewire. Being so close to water here in Bewsey, being safe in water is such an important life skill for our children - we are doing everything we can but you too can help by taking them to the local pool as much as possible.

## **MALALA'S BIRTHDAY!**


