Tuck Shop

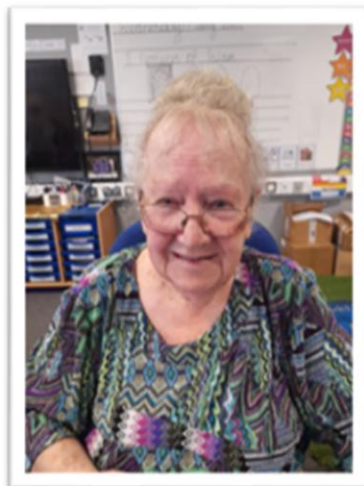
