SPRING IS IN THE AIR!

It has been lovely to see all the children back this week and to see glimpses of sunshine through the rain. Spring is certainly starting to feel like it's on its way. It has been a very egg-citing week for Reception, following the arrival of 10 white eggs on Monday. With guesses of crocodiles and snakes, it wasn't long before the first one hatched revealing a very cute duckling.



Over the week, the children have continued to watch very closely as each of the eggs has hatched. They have kept duck diaries, made duck artwork, labelled the different parts of a duck and written instructions on how to best look after ducklings.



As they grow incredibly quickly, the ducklings will be leaving school next Thursday. Some will be

re-homed with members of staff and others will return to one of four branch farms that have signed the 'Rare Breeds Survival Trust Pledge,' which helps to protect breeds from extinction and ensures the birds have a good life, worth living. As they are still very small and featherless, we are still unsure of the breeds our ducks are, they could be Pekins, Runner Ducks, Appleyards, Cayugas or Khaki Campbells. Most of these breeds do not fly but all of them will enjoy a lovely bath.
